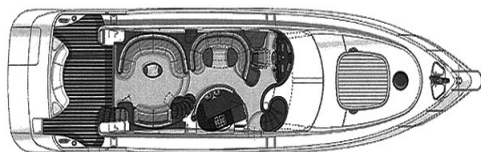
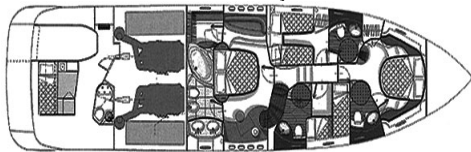


Azimut 68 Plus; 68 Evolution

Beautifully styled and impeccably detailed, the Azimut 68 Plus (called the 68 Evolution in 2005-07) is an impressive balance of advanced engineering, luxurious accommodations and excellent performance. Offered with three or four staterooms, the Azimut 68 is as versatile as she is comfortable. Entering through a sliding stainless steel glass door from the aft deck, the palatial main salon features a C-shaped sofa to port and smaller settee to starboard. Forward of the salon and two steps up are the dinette and galley. A sliding cherry tambour door allows the galley to be separated from the dining area. Below, the Azimut's amidships master suite features a king bed, leather settee, vertical hull windows, and ensuite bath with tub. The VIP stateroom at the bow has a queen berth, and the guest stateroom(s) have single berths. The Azimut 68s covered aft deck includes a curved settee with table and a stairway to the flybridge. Like many Italian yachts, the engine room and crew quarters are small, and the lower helm suffers from limited visibility. Topside, the flybridge features a teak sole, U-shaped seating area, barbecue and refrigerator. MTU 1360hp diesels cruise at 26-28 knots (30+ top).
