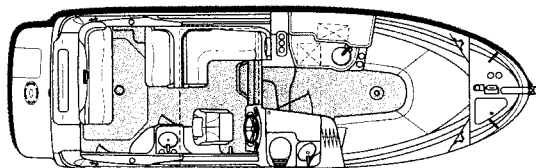


Sea Ray 260 Sundancer

Arguably the best selling 26-foot trailerable cruiser ever, the Sea Ray 260 Sundancer set the class standards in her day for upscale accommodations and leading-edge design. Her midcabin interior sleeps four comfortably and includes a full standup head with shower, glossy cherrywood cabinetry, full-service galley with stove and microwave, four opening ports, and snap-in carpet runners. In the cockpit, the lounge at the stern folds away when not in use, and a wet bar with sink and cooler is standard. A walk-thru windshield provides easy access to the foredeck. Note the molded steps built into in the sliding companionway door. The extended swim platform has a concealed stainless steel ladder. Additional features include a gas-assist engine hatch, cockpit shower, portside sun lounger, flip-up helm seat, rod holders, cockpit table, tilt wheel, anchor locker, and large transom storage compartment. A reverse arch was a popular option. Heavily built on a solid fiberglass hull, a single 310hp MerCruiser sterndrive will cruise the 260 Sundancer in the low 20s (about 35 knots top).
