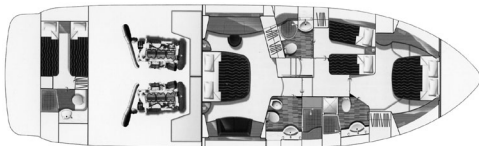


Viking Sport Cruisers 67 Motoryacht

A blend of sophisticated styling and state-of-the-art construction, the Viking Sport Cruisers 67 raised the bar for yachting elegance when she was introduced in 2004. In the eyes of many brokers, Princess Yachts—manufacturer of the Viking Sport Cruisers series—had been the leading builder of European luxury yachts for many years. Indeed, the impressive finish of the 67 Motoryacht comes as no surprise to those familiar with the company's reputation for quality. Built on a deep-V hull with prop pockets, the spacious three-stateroom, three-head interior of the VSC 67 features a spacious salon with facing leather settees, wet bar, and entertainment center. The galley (with upright refrigerator and dishwasher) and dinette are on the pilothouse level, two steps up from the salon. An innovative glass galley partition turns translucent at the flip of a switch. Below, the 67 boasts an opulent full-beam master with king-size berth, vertical hull windows, and copious storage. Additional features include aft crew quarters, electric dinette window, swim platform davit, and teak decks. MAN 1,100hp diesels cruise at 25–26 knots (close to 30 top).
